



Unit Overview Joshua



In Hebrews 11:30, the writer of Hebrews spoke of Joshua's faith without mentioning his name: "By faith the walls of Jericho fell down after being encircled by the Israelites for seven days." Of course, this faith wasn't just Joshua's, but the Israelites' as well. In addition to what it says about faith, this verse testifies to Joshua's effectiveness as a leader. Actually, Moses' successor led effectively on many levels. He offered a consistent example of trusting God, and he acted on that trust. He also faithfully challenged and warned God's people regarding obedience to the Lord in the new land. This unit explores Joshua's faith in God and his leadership of God's people, and it affirms the positive difference these influences made in God's unfolding story.

Lesson 1: "Joshua Explored the Promised Land" (Numbers 13:1-33; 14:6-9)
Bible Truth: I can trust God to help me do what is hard.

Lesson 2: "Joshua—The New Leader" (Joshua 1:1-18)
Bible Truth: I can trust God to help me be strong and courageous.

Lesson 3: "God Stopped the River" (Joshua 3-4)
Bible Truth: God is mighty and powerful.

Lesson 4: "The Fall of Jericho" (Joshua 6)
Bible Truth: God is great and mighty.
